TOURNAMENT RULES

1. United States Bowling Congress Rules and Regulations will govern the Tournament.
2. All Prizes (Team, Doubles, Singles and All Events) will be based on a handicap basis.
3. There will be one (1) cash prize for each five (5) entries in Team, Doubles and Singles Events and one (1) cash prize for each five (5) entries in All Events. Trophies will be awarded to the winner of the Team, Doubles, Singles and All Events. The prize fee will be returned 100% with the first place not to exceed 40% of the prize fund. Based on the number of entries, tournament manager may adjust the 1 in 5 rule.
4. A prize list will be posted in the bowling establishment.
5. An overall All Event's Champion will be awarded a plaque but to be eligible for All Event prize money a \$10.00 (optional) fee per person must be paid.
6. Handicap will be computed on a basis of 90% of the difference between each bowler's average and 210.
7. Average used will be the highest league average based on 21 games for the 2025-2026 season in the Greater Johnson City Area Bowling Association. An entrant without an average for the 2025-2026 season may use the highest league average based on 21 games for the 2026-2027 season as of October 12, 2026 (12:01 am). All others will bowl scratch, Average 210.
8. Current membership in the Greater Johnson City Area Bowling Association and USBC is required. Non-members may enter by paying an association membership fee and bowl scratch.
9. No change in the team lineup will be allowed unless substitution is involved. A substitute must bowl in the same position as the bowler replaced.
10. Entries may bowl two (2) times in team event, but not more than three (3) players on the same team may place more than one (1) time on prize list.
 - (a) A bowler participating more than once in the team event must count their first score for all events.
 - (b) A bowler must enter both Doubles and Singles if they are entered in either event.
 - (c) An entrant may bowl only once in Doubles and Singles. Exception: at the tournament site, a bowler will be allowed to bowl an additional time as a substitute in the doubles event only to fill unexpected vacancies but can only place once on prize list.
11. In case of a protest, call Tournament Manager at once. (Catherine Saylor @ 423-319-6302)
12. Bowlers are required to be ready to bowl at least **20 minutes** before scheduled start time. A bowler who arrives after a game has started may bowl but must start to bowl and score to count beginning with the frame being bowled. No score will be given for the frames that are missed. All bowlers must be ready to bowl when it is their turn to bowl. In the event a late bowler has been replaced by a substitute, then the substitute will be allowed to finish the series.
13. In the case of emergencies or scheduling problems, changes in the tournament schedule may be made at the discretion of the tournament manager.
14. All entrants are cautioned to be aware of the re-rating requirements of USBC Rule 319E.
15. USBC Rule 319 (Parts A-3 and D) are in effect. Part A-3 requires each bowler to be responsible for the accuracy of their average and Part D requires that each bowler report winnings of \$600.00 or more to the Tournament Manager at the time of entry. USBC Rule 319 (Part A-2) is also in effect (10 pin drop rule). If the bowler is 10 pins higher as of October 12, 2026 (12:01 am) then the 21-game average will apply.
16. In case of a tie for first place (Team, Doubles or Singles), then co-champions will be declared.
17. Entries will be scheduled as they are received. Preference will be given to the earliest received.
18. There will be a limitation of two (2) professional bowlers per team in the four (4) person event and one (1) per team in the two (2) person event.
